**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S MOTION TO RETAIN SPECIAL
COUNSEL NUNC PRO TUNC**

THIS CAUSE is before the Court upon the Receiver's Motion to Retain Special Counsel *Nunc Pro Tunc*, ECF No. [227] (the "Motion"), filed on August 20, 2019. The Receiver seeks to retain the law firm of Damian & Valori LLP to represent the Receiver for the purposes of investigating, pursuing, and litigating certain clawback litigations against various third parties. The Receiver has submitted a proposed retainer agreement indicating that Melissa Damian Visconti will have primary responsibility for the representation and litigation on behalf of Damian & Valori LLP. *See* ECF No. [227-1] (the "Proposed Retainer Agreement"). Having considered the Motion,

and finding that good cause exists to grant the Motion, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. The Motion, **ECF No. [227]**, is **GRANTED**.
2. The Receiver is authorized to retain Damian & Valori LLP as counsel for the Receiver *nunc pro tunc* to August 20, 2019.
3. The Receiver is authorized to execute the Proposed Retainer Agreement.
